#### Therefore, please may we remind you

that under the terms of your tenancy agreement you are required to keep the garden properly maintained, reasonably free from weeds, in a neat and tidy condition and any lawns mown and trees and shrubs pruned.

### Grass Should be kept at a reasonable height and cut at regular intervals.

#### *Shrubs and Plants* These should not overhang paths, neighbours' gardens or access ways.

# Hedges Should be below 2 meters high and should not overhang pathways in a way that may be dangerous to others.

#### • Trees

Should be kept manageable. Branches should not be left in a dangerous condition for example, overly long or broken and subsequently hanging down from the tree. If they start causing structural damage or are dangerous please contact our office.

#### • Litter and Waste The garden should be kept clear of litter and waste at all times.
